PROJECT: RHYMES.

AGE GROUP: 5 - 6 YEARS (It can be extended and adapted to other age groups)

ACTIVITY 1

FIRINFINFELA (Brazilian traditional name rhyme)

Speak the names and find end rhymes.

Introduce the game *Firinfinfela* and ask students to try to repeat the rhyme with their own names.

Follow the rhythm of the words with clapping or any other body percussion of your choice.

Then play the rhythm only in the final part of each rhyme.

Explore different movements for the rhymes invented and then create movement sequences with the students.
