AGE GROUP: 4-5 YEARS (It can be extended and adapted to other age groups)

Macaca Sofia is a Brazilian traditional nursey rhyme.

ACTIVITY 1

Start with a body warm-up:

Interpret and dramatize the lyrics.

The arms make the movement of the clock following the woodblock sound.

ACTIVITY 2

Ask students to choose a part of the body to follow the pulse, and then to create short rhythmic patterns (color part) complementing the arrangement.

Sing the melody with rhythmical accompaniment using your body or a sound object.
